MESCO's Medical Aid department has been working with various government hospitals such as L.T.M.G. Hospital, K.E.M. Hospital, B.Y.L. Nair Hospital, J.J. Hospital, G.T. Hospital, St. George Hospital, Bhabha Hospital since its inception. With the help of its donors MESCO provides financial assistance to the poor patients for their surgeries and treatments at Govt. hospitals. MESCO was invited by the Social Service Department of

sessions on Detection and prevention of kidney disease and diet in Kidney disease and Chronic renal failure disease respectively. The programme was very informative and proved to be very useful for the patients.



The 6 months Dialysis Form Distribution programme took place on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 at Anjuman Islam, Khalifa Ziauddin Girls Primary School, Mahim. 87 patients turned up for the same. 37 beneficiaries were selected



through lottery, patients came from across Mumbai. The application is under process and the patients will be given medical aid assistance to cover their 6 months dialysis cost.

## **GRATITUDE STORY**

Baby Nirvi is 3 yrs old girl, was suffering from Pre-B Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (type of blood cancer). When the family got to know about her disease it was a nightmare for them. Baby Nirvi required Chemotherapy treatment at Bai Jerabai Wadia Hospital for the children and needed further line of treatment. The cost of treatment was Rs. 3,00,000/- and it was becoming



increasingly difficult for the family to manage expenses. They had exhausted their personal savings and help received from relatives was also limited. Nirvi's father was the sole earning member of the 5 members family living in a rented house with very basic amenities at Mira Road. He was working as a salesman at a garment shop, earning a nominal income of Rs. 10,000/- p.m. With these limited resources it was very difficult for the family to arrange for the funds. Nirvi's father ran from pillar to post for the arrangement of funds. He was guided to MESCO by the hospital. It was a Nirvi's father's faith that she will live a normal life one day. MESCO helped her and also guided them to approach other trusts for help. Due to timely treatment, today Nirvi is able to live a normal life. The family is very thankful to all the donors for their timely assistance.

### **Sewing Machine Lottery**

• Every month detail of beneficiaries are taken in the given format on phone. Later we draw lottery through software for Zakat and Non Zakat cases separately. Selected beneficiaries are called at office along-with documents and are registered, then a trade test is conducted followed by personal interview at our office and finally selected cases are called in the office to collect the Sewing Machine.

- A webinar for Pre-Primary Teachers on Jolly Phonics was conducted by SAAR Education. The resource person Ms. Sue Lloyd briefed on "How teacher can teach reading and writing to children". By teaching letter sounds, story by action, letter formation, blending words identifying sounds, Digraphs (ck,sh,th,nk,ng), reading practice etc. Dictation is the most effective way of revising letter sound and practicing the skill needed for writing. It was a good interactive session. All the Pre-Primary Section teachers attended the session.
- The Teacher Training Foundation has been at the forefront of teacher training since 2022. Their programmes cater to the diverse needs of schools. TTF had offered these programmes online to facilitate continuous professional development anytime and anywhere. The programme was scheduled for 2 years.
