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EDITORIAL

The last quarter marked significant progress across MESCO and MESCO Education Society (MES), reaffirming our commitment to education and community welfare.

Inductions under the Education Adoption Scheme (EAS) commenced successfully. While the Educational Aid (EA) school-level application process concluded on 30th June, the scholarship lottery is scheduled for July.

Academic achievements remained outstanding, with EAS students achieving a 100% SSC pass rate and 98.99% and 100% pass rates in the HSC Science and Commerce streams, respectively. MESCO supported BMC schools also recorded impressive SSC results: R.C. Mahim (95.74%), Bandra Petit (90.47%), and Kurar Village Municipal School (100%). In addition, MES institutions achieved a 100% pass rate in both the SSC and HSC Board examinations.

MESCO further strengthened its healthcare outreach through a partnership with Crystal Eye Centre, Mazgaon, providing affordable cataract surgeries for eligible patients.

These achievements were made possible through the continued support of our Donors, Committee members, Volunteers, Staff, Students, and Well-wishers.

- The school-level Educational Aid (EA) Scholarship online forms closed on 30th June 2026. The lottery is scheduled for 15th July 2026. The online application for college-level scholarships is open until 15th July 2026.

Dr. Aarif Ansari's journey reflects the power of determination and timely support. Coming from a modest family and facing financial hardships, he remained committed to his education. During Class IX, he received support through MESCO's Education Adoption Scheme (EAS), and later through the High-Cost Education Scheme (HCES) while pursuing medical studies. With perseverance and MESCO's support, Dr. Aarif completed his BAMS and PGDEMS qualifications and now runs his own healthcare facility, Saiban Advance Care Clinic in Vikhroli, serving the community with dedication and compassion. Reflecting on his journey, Dr. Aarif shares,

MEDICAL DEPARTMENT

During the quarter, MESCO extended medical assistance to **76** beneficiaries under the LSMA Scheme for major treatments and surgeries. In addition, support was provided to **37** patients under the MA (Medical Aid) Scheme for their monthly medicines, **36** patients for minor treatments and surgeries, and **48** dialysis patients to help meet their dialysis expenses.



MESCO, in collaboration with Crystal Eye Centre, Mazgaon, has launched a Free Cataract Surgery initiative for eligible & deserving patients.

A nominal registration fee of Rs.1,000 is payable by the patient directly at Crystal Eye Centre.

A New Beginning for Shakikullah

16 years old Shakikullah had been living with severe dorsolumbar scoliosis, a spinal deformity that caused a painful hump on his back, making it difficult for him to walk and carry out daily activities.

Doctors at KEM Hospital recommended corrective surgery costing Rs.1.6 lakh, but for his family of five, surviving on his father's monthly income of Rs.10,000 as an electrician, the cost was far beyond their means. As a result, the surgery was delayed for over a year.

At this critical time, MESCO stepped forward with financial assistance, making the life-changing surgery possible. Today, Shakikullah has regained his normal posture, is free from pain, and can lead a healthy, independent life.



His family expresses their heartfelt gratitude to MESCO and its generous donors for their timely support, which gave Shakikullah a second chance at life.

During the last quarter, the MESCO Medical-Aid Dispensary, located in Mumbra, Amrut Nagar, successfully provided primary medical care to **3013** patients.
