Your incredible compassion in the form of Zakat and donations towards impoverished and insolvent communities - in spite of going through difficult tests yourselves has humbled and inspired us.

We have been busy more than ever this Quarter and have been able to assist the community in so many ways, few of the main highlights of the previous quarter are as follows

Our dedicated **Clinic department** provided quality primary health care to 3661 patients at Medical-Aid Dispensary, Mumbra and 409 patients at Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre. A total of 434 patients received primary health care at the Umair Khopekar Memorial Clinic.

Our hardworking **Medical department** organized **Free Health Check-up camps** at the Imamwada compound and Radiant School, Mumbra on 7th January, 2024 and 18th February 2024 in which 223 patients and 680 patients availed the benefit of the medical services respectively.

During the month of March 2024, our **Relief of Poverty department** conducted three distributions of Ration kits in Mahim and Mumbra, catering to the essentials of the 1070 susceptible members of our community.

To improve and enrich the quality of education, we distributed **Educational kits and note books** to SSC students in our **adopted Municipal schools namely RC Mahim and Kurar village (Malad).**

We would also like to share that we have announced **Educational Scholarship dates** for the year of 2024-25, the same is shared in the main body of the newsletter and also available on our website.


Ansari Shabeena Shakeel

MEDICAL **

MESCO organized a Free Health Check-up camp at the Imamwada compound, Mumbai on 7th Jan 2024, in which 223 patients availed the benefit of the medical services. The camp offered comprehensive care,



including basic health check-ups, blood pressure monitoring, blood sugar tests, Orthopedic and Gynecology consultations, optometry, and BMI-BMD assessments.

- MESCO organized **Health Awareness program** regarding kidney disease on 18th Feb 2024 at Radiant School, Mumbra. The program was attended by Dialysis, Chronic kidney disease, and Diabetic patients. Renowned nephrologist Dr. Pooja Binani conducted a session on "Detection and Prevention of Kidney Disease," while Dietician Ms. Sana Sarang Shaikh guided patients on "Diet Management in Chronic Kidney Diseases and Renal Failures." These informative sessions were attended by 89 patients,
- Radiant School on Sunday, 18th Feb 2024. We were able to serve a total of 680 patients in the camp through our team of Doctors. The camp offered various medical services free of cost including basic health check-ups, blood pressure monitoring, blood sugar tests,

Orthopedic, Dental, ENT, and Gynecological consultations, optometric examinations with glasses at the rate of Rs.120/only, and BMI-BMD assessments. The free health check-up camp organized by MESCO was a great success and a great help to all the beneficiaries who attended the camp.

 6 months Dialysis Form **Distribution** was held at Anjuman Islam, Khalifa Ziauddin Girls Primary School, Mahim on 3rd March 2024. 77 patients turned up for the distribution. Through a random selection process, 25 beneficiaries



were chosen for the medical assistance for their 6 months dialysis expenses.

GRATITUDE STORY

In the slums of Dharavi, lives a family of six struggling to make ends meet. Their world revolves around their 12-year-old son, Mohd. Huzaifa, who is battling Acute Myeloid leukemia (type of a cancer). Every day is a fight against the disease, but also against poverty. Huzaifa's parents work tirelessly to support their



Mohd Huzaifa family, earning a meager income by sticking envelopes at home.

Their monthly earnings of around Rs. 12,000/- barely cover their basic necessities.

Hope seemed when MESCO Trust stepped in to their life as a helping hand. MESCO supported Huzaifa, for his BMT and chemotherapy expenses at Tata Hospital. It was a ray of hope in their darkest hour. Despite the challenges they face, Huzaifa's family finds strength in each other. Their gratitude towards MESCO Trust has no end, for them without MESCO's support, Huzaifa's fight would be even harder.

They may live in slums, but their spirits are rich with hope and gratitude.

RELIEF OF POVERTY (ROP)

its unwavering dedication to tackling the multifaceted challenges posed by poverty. Through strategic initiatives such as monthly ration kit distributions, quarterly sewing machine provisions, and Ramzan kit distributions, the program continues to effect positive change in the lives of hundreds of families experiencing hardship.

SEWING MACHINE DISTRIBUTION

The Sewing machine distribution program has demonstrated notable progress over the past three months. During this period, a total of 128 beneficiaries were registered. Of these, 70 individuals were meticulously selected through a transparent lottery system, subsequently undergoing trade tests and personal interviews.

On February 24th, 2024, a pivotal event unfolded at the Landmark office in Mahim West, where 31 sewing machines were distributed to deserving individuals. This initiative aimed to equip recipients with valuable stitching skills, particularly benefiting the less privileged members of our community.

RATION SUPPORT SCHEME

Under our Ration Support Scheme, we have distributed dry rations in 10 different areas. We provided ration support to the 34 elderly residents of Kaynaat Old Age Home in Uttan.In March, a total of 461 beneficiaries received ration support, aimed at addressing the • SSC Farewell program and 'How to prepare for Exams' basic needs of individuals facing economic hardship.

RATION KIT DISTRIBUTION

During the month of March 2024, MESCO conducted three distributions of Ration kits in various locations, catering to the needs of the most vulnerable members of the community. The first distribution, held



on 9th March 2024, saw the distribution of 500 Ration kits at MESCO's Landmark office and MESCO's Crescent School in Mumbra. The second distribution, on 23rd March 2024, witnessed the distribution of 400 kits at MESCO's Landmark office and the Radiant School in Mumbra. Finally, on 30th March, **170** Ration kits were distributed at MESCO's Landmark office in Mahim West.
