MEDICAL

- MESCO was honored by KEM Hospital on 23rd January 2025, for the valuable medical assistance provided to their patients.
- •MESCO organized the "World Kidney Day" program and "Medical Camp" on Sunday 2nd February 2025 at Crescent English High School, Mumbra.





- The World Kidney Day Program was attended by 90 patients with chronic kidney disease. Dr. M.Y. Khokhawala (Senior consultant nephrologist) led a session on "Early detection and prevention of kidney disease", while Dietician Ms. Humera Poonawala conducted a session on "Managing kidney disorders through diet".
- ➤ Free Medical camp provided a wide range of healthcare services to underprivileged patients, A total of 386 patients benefited from the services offered by the camp. The Events provided Valuable services and care to the Community.
- •6 months Dialysis Form Distribution was held at Anjuman

Islam, Khalifa Ziauddin Girls Primary School, Mahim on 2nd March, 2025. 97 patients turned up for the distribution. Through a random selection process, 30 beneficiaries were chosen for the medical assistance for their 6 months dialysis expenses.



•MESCO distributed cheques on 19th and 22nd March 2025 respectively to needy and deserving patients undergoing cancer and high-cost treatments at a government hospital in Mumbai. This support was made possible through the generous CSR contributions from Nadiadwala Grandsons and Rashtriya Chemicals and Fertilizers (RCF). GRATITUDE STORY

A Breath of Hope - Dhanaji Parvi's Journey to Survival



Dhanaji Parvi aged 61 years, a resident of the slums of Kurla, has been suffering from Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) since 2022. With only his daughter earning a meager Rs. 4000 per month through domestic work, the family struggled to meet medical expenses. Dhanaji's condition worsened, and he could hardly breathe. Doctors at LTMG

Hospital advised him to use an oxygen concentrator for survival, but the cost was beyond his reach.

MESCO stepped in, covering the balance amount for the oxygen concentrator, while RCF generously sponsored his case. This support gave Dhanaji a much-needed breath of relief, allowing him to live a more normal life. Dhanaji is thankful to MESCO and RCF for their timely help, which has brought him hope and the chance to breathe continuously.

CLINICS

- In the last quarter, the Medical-Aid Dispensary in Mumbra, Amrut Nagar, provided primary medical care to 3846 patients.
 Additionally, the Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre offered physiotherapy services to 494 patients.

SEWING MACHINE DISTRIBUTION

Empowerment begins with opportunity. This quarter, 250 beneficiaries were registered, and 100 individuals were selected through a fair lottery process. After a rigorous trade test and interview, 57 sewing machines were distributed on 22nd February 2025 from MESCO Landmark Office, Mahim. The event was a testament to resilience and determination, as beneficiaries shared their journey and gratitude.



RATION SUPPORT SCHEME

For many struggling families, a simple meal is a true blessing. This quarter, 453 beneficiaries, across 10 locations, received essential dry rations including the elderly residents at Kaynaat Old Age Home, Uttan ensuring food security for the most vulnerable. Additionally, we provided Iftar kits to these needy families.

IFTAR KIT DISTRIBUTION

The spirit of Ramzan was embraced with kindness as 1,640 Iftar packets were distributed in three phases:

- Vocational Education and Training has been renewed for an additional three years, reaffirming the centre's affiliation with the esteemed board.
- MES VTC has launched the Voltas MEP project training in collaboration with Fr. Agnel Technical College, Bandra. It is a placement-linked training program designed to enhance employability.
