GRATITUDE STORY



Mr. Santosh Kukreja, a resident of Ulhasnagar, struggling with epilepsy and have undergone brain tumor surgery at J.J hospital. Living with his wife and four other family members, Santosh's dream of a normal life seemed distant due to his health conditions and financial problems.

Despite his health issues, Santosh works as a salesman in a readymade garment shop, earning a salary of Rs 12,000 per month. His wife supports the family by giving tuitions. Yet, their combined efforts often fall short, especially when it comes to the high cost of Santosh's medications, which are essential for managing his epilepsy and post-surgery recovery. Due to financial burden, often he skips his medications, leading to frequent health setbacks and making it impossible for him to lead a normal life.

However, a ray of hope emerged when Santosh's name was selected in MESCO's lottery system for monthly medications under MA scheme. This blessing came at a crucial time. With the continuous supply of his required medications, Santosh's health began to stabilize. Santosh is profoundly grateful to the donors whose timely help has made a significant difference in his life.

CLINICS

- •During the quarter, the clinic department provided quality primary health care to 2837 patients at Medical-Aid Dispensary, Mumbra, Amrut Nagar. Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre has shifted to a new location (Address: Shop. No. 04, Sahara Apartment, Maharaja Corner Lane, Amrut Nagar, Mumbra) since 20 June 2024 and provided physiotherapy services to 237 patients during the reporting quarter.

& RELIEF OF POVERTY

The Relief of Poverty program, administered by MESCO, persists in its unwavering dedication to tackling the multifaceted challenges posed by poverty. Through strategic initiatives such as monthly ration kit distributions, quarterly sewing machine provisions, and Ramzan kit distributions, the program continues to effect positive change in the lives of hundreds of families experiencing hardship.

SEWING MACHINE DISTRIBUTION

The sewing machine distribution program has demonstrated notable progress over the past three months. During this period, a total of 178 beneficiaries were registered. Of these, 58 individuals were meticulously selected through a transparent lottery system, subsequently undergoing trade tests and personal interviews.
