### This quarter, 432 patients from government hospitals approached MESCO on the first three days of the lottery for medical assistance for their expensive surgeries and cancer treatments under LSMA scheme. Of these, MESCO provided financial assistance to 175 patients under the Life Saving Medical Aid scheme. 63 patients suffering from chronic diseases were provided with monthly medication and 36 patients received support for minor surgeries and diagnostic tests under the Medical Aid scheme. 43 dialysis patients received financial support for their dialysis treatment.

### **QUARTER FULL OF ACTIVITIES**

- •A free medical check-up camp was organised at Umair Khopekar Memorial Clinic & Physiotherapy Centre on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2023. Free medicines, bone mineral density (BMD) test, random blood sugar (RBS) test and physiotherapy check-up were the highlights of the camp. A total of 123 patients took part in the camp and received free medication after consulting our doctor.
- •On 24<sup>th</sup> December 2023, a free medical check-up camp was organised at Medical-Aid Dispensary, Mumbra. Free optometry test, random blood sugar testing (RBS) and blood pressure checkup were the major features of the camp. A total of 121 patients benefited through the camp.

# 🔉 RELIEF OF POVERTY (ROP)

The Relief of Poverty program remains steadfast in its commitment to address the challenges associated with poverty. Our initiatives, including monthly ration kit distributions and quarterly sewing machine provisions, continue to make a positive impact on hundreds of families in need.

## **SEWING MACHINE DISTRIBUTION**

Over the past three months, our sewing machine distribution program has shown commendable progress. A total of 237 beneficiaries were registered in previous quarter out of which 50 individuals were selected through a transparent lottery system, which was followed by successful completion of trade tests and personal interviews. These beneficiaries have now received their sewing machines, representing a significant step towards self-sufficiency.
